

Town of Boulder Junction SUMMER REC PROGRAM - 2021

Hello to all **residents and visitors** of the Boulder Junction area. We are happy to be offering the Summer Rec Program again for the summer of 2021 for 6 weeks from 6/21/2021-7/30/2021. The following is a **preliminary** schedule to what this year's program will include.

My name is Lanette "Lani" Nelson, I am excited to continue as the Summer Recreation Program Director. I, myself, grew up in Boulder Junction and attended the Rec Program, and know the importance of the program. I, along with my two assistants will staff the program. I am an elementary school teacher with coaching and after school program experience, as well as being the rec director since 2016. We have CPR and First Aid training and are looking forward to working with the area children. Again this year we invite your **youngsters, ages 6 to 13, who have completed kindergarten**, to attend the summer program. The following is a preview of what this year's program will include.

In the mornings, we have planned various sports/activities for the children. We hope to expose them and give them experience with some of these activities. Some mornings we will have an art/craft activity. Again, this year on Wednesdays, we will be attending the Boulder Junction Public Library Children's Summer Reading Program. Be sure to sign up for a library card, if you haven't done so already, and keep your child reading over the summer months. The swimming program will be on various days again this year and as you will notice, the lessons are given at different beaches on different days. We are hoping that the water temp will rise quickly in order to provide lessons for them as soon as possible.

It is very important that parents look at the schedule each morning to find out what we are doing for the day, the costs of the events, and the times we are leaving and returning, and if anything special should be packed for the day.

Please note that we have a Daily Fee to help keep the Boulder Rec. Program running. (Please send CASH for the Daily Fee, NO CHECKS) Also, many of our rain day activities cost money, so, *if it looks like rain or if it's cold outside, make sure your child has money* for that event. If you have any questions or helpful comments, please, don't hesitate to call us.

This year we will run the program for six weeks. Again, please **CHECK THE ACTIVITY SCHEDULE, DAILY FOR COSTS, TIMES AND ANY CHANGES**. Also **the children need to bring their own lunch and a water bottle daily**, unless noted lunch is provided. **Don't forget sunscreen.** Covid-19 protocols as applicable will be followed so be sure your child wears a mask each day.

If there is a need to contact us, you can leave a message at the community building (715-385-2220) with the town clerk, Dan Driscoll, and we will get back to you as soon as we can. We hope you're able to come and have some fun with us for at least a few days this summer! Thank you for supporting your program!
